(Lick 1) (Lick 3) (Lick 4)

This system contains the first three licks. Lick 1 is a triplet of eighth notes in the right hand. Lick 3 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand. Lick 4 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand with accents. The bass line consists of a steady eighth-note accompaniment.

(Lick 7) (Lick 8) (Lick 9)

This system contains licks 7, 8, and 9. Lick 7 is a triplet of eighth notes in the right hand. Lick 8 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand. Lick 9 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand. The bass line continues with eighth-note accompaniment.

(Lick 10) (Lick 13)

This system contains licks 10 and 13. Lick 10 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand with an accent. Lick 13 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand with triplets. The bass line continues with eighth-note accompaniment.

(Lick 20) (Lick 17)

This system contains licks 20 and 17. Lick 20 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand with a triplet. Lick 17 is a sequence of eighth notes in the right hand with a triplet. The bass line continues with eighth-note accompaniment.
